9. Discuss and consider approving the full-time employment of Eddie Bishop for the position of Deputy Sheriff for the Andrews County Sheriff's Department at the Deputy III, Step V rate of \$26.30, plus Master Certification pay of \$500.00 per month effective May 26, 2020.

10. Discuss and consider approving the Master Certification pay in the amount of \$100.00 per month for Margaret Hathcox, dispatcher with the Andrews County Sheriff's Office effective May 21, 2020.
11. Discuss and consider approving the Advanced Certification pay in the amount of \$75.00 per month for Angelica Guzman, dispatcher with the Andrews County Sheriff's Office effective May 21, 2020.
12. Discuss and consider approving the Basic Certification pay in the amount of \$25.00 per month for Travis Edwards, dispatcher with the Andrews County Sheriff's Office effective May 21, 2020.

Discuss and consider approving a lease purchase quote between Andrews County and John Deere Financial for two 2500B PrecisionCut gas riding greens mowers, two 7700A PrecisionCut fairway mowers, one 9009A TerrainCut rough mower and one 1200A bunker and field rake to be paid from the General Fund in four annual payments of \$62064.77 with a balloon payment of \$43,058.70 in the fifth year carrying an approximate interest rate of 3.2% per annum for a total cost of \$274,682.97 priced through Sourcewell Grounds Maintenance 062117-DAC (PG NB CG 70) contract. This quote has an option of selling back the above-listed equipment to John Deere Financial for \$43,058.70 at the end of the five-year lease or applying the \$43,058.70 towards a subsequent purchase.
17. Discuss and consider approving the purchase of one John Deere 1600 Turbo Series III commercial wide area mower with 2-post folding ROPS for \$58,520.48 under Sourcewell Grounds Maintenance 062117-DAC (PG NB CG 70) contract to be paid out of the General Fund.

18. Consider approving the various budget amendments and / or line item transfers for the 2019-2020 budget years under Local Government Code 111.010(d).

19. Consider approving the payment of financial obligations and payroll for Andrews County.
