

NOTICE OF 2017 TAX YEAR PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR

Andrews County

A tax rate of \$0.5157 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Andrews County. This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate.

The governing body of Andrews County proposes to use revenue attributable to the tax rate increase for the purpose of Providing for the needs of the County.

- PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.5157 per \$100
- PRECEDING YEAR'S TAX RATE \$0.5655 per \$100
- EFFECTIVE TAX RATE \$0.4778 per \$100
- ROLLBACK TAX RATE \$0.5160 per \$100

The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Andrews County from the same properties in both the 2016 tax year and the 2017 tax year.

The rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate that Andrews County may adopt before voters are entitled to petition for an election to limit the rate that may be approved to the rollback rate.

property tax amount = (rate) x (taxable value of your property) / 100***
